STEM OUTREACH WITH A MISSION

The love of science, technology, engineering and math begins early. When young students are supported and encouraged in their exploration of these and other critical STEM disciplines, they are far more likely to continue seeking out more information, laying the groundwork for an in-demand, technologically-fueled career.

Florida Polytechnic University's Office of Educational Outreach connects with K-12 educators, community organizations, and local event organizers to share their knowledge and demonstrate how science, technology, engineering, and math (STEM) matter in their lives.

EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH

Florida Poly's Educational Outreach office facilitates communication between the K-12 educational community and the University. Educational entities often partner with the University for efforts such as:

- Requesting guest speakers for STEM-related events
- Judging science and engineering fairs
- · Requesting exhibitors for educational and community STEM events
- Participating in our "Outreach to the Future" program at the University, in which middle and high school students tour the campus, talk to faculty, staff, and students about the Florida Poly experience, and take part in a hands-on STEM activity
