TENT PERMIT – GUIDELINES

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A PURPOSE:

This **BCA Directive** addresses the <u>Section 3103 (Temporary Structures)</u>, Florida Building Code requirement to permitting and approval prior to erection of any tents larger than 120 SF (Square Feet). This special permit process shall comply with the Florida Poly <u>Building Code Administration (BCA)</u> Program.

Submit permit application with Site plan, including tent size (area of tent in SF), intended use of tent, tent tiedown and ballasting method, flame retardant rating and location with relations to any buildings, etc. where and when it will be placed/removed from campus. Submit the permit application and supporting information to the BCO at Florida Poly Facilities & Safety Services, Lakeland Campus, via email:

safetyservices@floridapoly.edu.

B REQUIREMENTS:

Intended use and layout for comments on meeting code compliance shall be included with the following criteria being met.

1.0 Emergency Lighting:

Tents larger than 1,200 SF shall be provided with emergency lighting if the use of the tent is at night per <u>Section 101.12.2.9.2, NFPA (Florida Fire Prevention Code)</u>. Battery backup lights that come on upon loss of power are required. Generator Powered lights are not considered emergency lighting without alternate power source. Exit signs required if tent structure has enclosed sides

2.0 Stages and Platforms:

A ramp shall be provided to all stages and platforms per Federal <u>Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA)</u> and <u>Section 201.3</u> (Temporary and Permanent Structures), Florida Accessibility Code for Building <u>Construction</u> requirements.

3.0 ADA Seating:

Seating layout shall incorporate ADA seating areas located on an accessible route(s).

4.0 Crowd Managers:

Crowd manager(s) shall be provided for 250 or more people and one per each 250 or fraction above 250 per <u>Section 101.12.7</u>, NFPA (Florida Fire Prevention Code).

5.0 Cooking Equipment:

Cooking equipment/barbeques are not allowed within the tents. Maintain 5 FT. minimum safe distance from the tents.

6.0 Exit Signage:

Exit signage either internally lighted or externally lighted for all tents with closed sides.

7.0 Electrical:

- i. Inspection of all wiring required prior to event.
- **ii.** Provide proper cable covers for all sound and power extension cords to prevent tripping hazards in aisles and walkways.
- **iii.** Use extension cords with proper grounding and GFCI (Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter) protection in all tents per <u>NEC (National Electric Code)</u> provisions.

8.0 Generators:

The use of Generators for power shall have a driven ground rod and generator frame to be connected with proper copper conductor to ground rod per <u>NEC (National Electric Code)</u> provisions.

9.0 Heating equipment:

Meet manufacturer's safety instructions and be UL Listed. LP (Liquid Propane) tanks to be a minimum of 5 FT away from any tents, secured in upright position, and protected from vehicular traffic.

10.0 Fire Extinguishers:

Provide fire extinguishers in all tents.

- i. Maximum mounting height measured from floor: 48".
- **ii.** Minimum size: 2-A:10-B:C.
- **iii.** Maximum travel distance from any point in the tent to an extinguisher: 75 FT.

iv. Brackets may be tie-wrapped; however, EXTINGUISHERS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE TIEWRAPPED TO THE TENT POLES, or otherwise made difficult to remove.

NFPA 110-6.1.3, Placement (of Fire Extinguishers)

6.1.3.1 Fire extinguishers shall be conspicuously located where they are readily accessible and immediately available in the event of fire.

6.1.3.2 Fire extinguishers shall be located along normal paths of travel, including exits from areas.

- **6.1.3.4***Portable fire extinguishers other than wheeled extinguishers shall be installed using any of the following means:
 - (1) Securely on a hanger intended for the extinguisher
 - (2) In the bracket supplied by the extinguisher manufacturer (bracket may be tie wrapped.)
 - (3) In a listed bracket approved for such purpose
 - (4) In cabinets or wall recesses

1. The site plan shall include the proposed location of the tent, as well as the distance (in ft.) between the tent and other structures on the site.

The completed application shall be submitted with the following items:

- 1. Certificate of Flame Resistance
- 2. Certificate of Insurance

Note:

- The validated receipt shall be at the site along with a copy of this packet.
- Tent permits are good for 30 days at a time not to exceed 180 days.
- Tent permit applications shall be submitted a minimum of 10 business days prior to setup date.
- There shall be a minimum of 30 ft. between the tent and any structures.
- There shall be a minimum of 10 ft. between stake/ballast lines.

The Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) has the right to deny this permit and any future permits if any of the above requirements are not adhered to.
